

A warm and playful colour, pink is an extremely versatile shade. It can be toned down with timber accents or paired with black for an industrial feel.


If vibrant decor is more your style, you can combine it with other energetic colours such as orange or green to achieve the perfect colour clash!

Cook it with AEG

Gnocchi with lemon & sage sauce, the perfect Valentines night showstopper.

Prep time: 20minsCooking time: 45mins

• Serves 2-4









ingredients

- 500g potatoes
- 160g flour
- 1 egg yolk
- 1½ tsp salt
- 1 pinch grated nutmeg
- Cornflour

For the sauce:

- ½ bunch sage
- 1 lemon
- 80g onion, finely chopped
- 40g butter
- Salt and pepper
- 50ml white wine
- 250ml cream



Chef Tip: Sprinkle with crispy bacon if you want to add salty flavour notes and more texture

directions

- Clean and peel the potatoes and bring to the boil. Let them cool completely, then mash
- Form a dough with potatoes, flour, egg yolk, salt, pepper and nutmeg. Divide into five and roll each piece into thumb-thick 'ropes', lightly sprinkling the surface with flour so that the dough does not stick
- Cut ropes into 2cm pieces and place on perforated steamer tray.
 Steam the gnocchi on shelf level 2 on Full Steam at 95°C for 30 minutes
- To prepare the sauce, snip sage leaves from the stems and set aside 8 leaves for garnish, finely chopping the rest. Zest and juice the lemon
- Sauté chopped onion in the butter and season to taste with salt and pepper. Add white wine and let it bubble for 2 minutes, add cream and reduce to two-thirds. Add the chopped sage leaves, lemon zest and lemon juice
- To serve, toss the steamed gnocchi in the sauce, then serve on preheated plates and garnish with sage leaves, a little grated
 Parmesan to taste, plus salt and pepper

Cook it with AEG

Chocolate orange madeleines, the sweet end to your romantic meal.

• Prep time: 10 mins

• Cooking time: 10-12 mins

• Serves 12-15 madeleines







ingredients

- 100g unsalted butter, plus extra for greasing
- 2 large eggs
- 100g golden caster sugar
- Zest of 2 oranges
- 2 tbsp orange juice
- 100g plain flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 140g dark chocolate (70% cocoa)
- You will need a 12-hole madeleine tin. This will make between 18-24 Madeleines depending on the size of the tin.



Chef Tip: Adding a pinch of salt into the melted dark chocolate creates a more complex flavour

directions

- Melt the butter until it is foamy and turns a nutty brown colour.

 Pour into a bowl and set aside to cool
- Beat eggs and sugar in an electric mixer, then add the orange zest and juice and mix until thick and pale. Add the melted butter and mix thoroughly. Combine flour and baking powder then add to the mixer a spoonful at a time and fold in carefully
- At this stage it may be chilled overnight.
- Add about one heaped tablespoon of the mixture to each madeleine hole (or pour the batter into a piping bag and pipe mixture into each hole)
- Bake on Low Humidity at 160 degrees for 10-12 minutes or until golden brown around the edges. Turn out immediately onto a wire rack and leave to cool
- In a saucepan melt the chocolate on a low setting on the induction hob
- Dip each madeleine halfway into the melted chocolate, allowing the excess to drip off, or drizzle the chocolate over the madeleine, then place on a sheet of baking parchment. Allow the chocolate to set before serving
