Ways to inject colour into your kitchen.

Colour can be a great addition to your kitchen; whether you wish to be daring with vibrant cabinetry or decide to inject a small touch of character through your textiles and accessories. Injecting colour into your kitchen has the power to change the whole mood and feel of your room.

Can't Decide? Think outside the box

Cook it with AEG

Delicious veggie tarts for your bonfire night celebrations!

- Preparation time: 10mins
- Cooking time: 20mins
- Serves 4-6
- Preheat the oven to 200°C







ingredients

- 1 packet ready rolled puff pastry
- 6 tsp pesto (approximately)
- Few mixed ripe cherry tomatoes
- 4 small courgettes
- 8 asparagus spears (cut into 3cm pieces keeping head pieces for the top of the tart)
- Basil leaves
- 100g mozzarella
- Splash of olive oil



Chef Tip: The dish works beautifully finished with a drizzle of reduced balsamic vinegar

directions

- Unroll the pastry and divide into equal sized rectangles. Using a knife, gently score a rectangle about 1cm inside to create the surface for the ingredients. Using the back of a teaspoon spread the centre of each rectangle with pesto, taking care to avoid the edges
- In a mixing bowl, squash the tomatoes before adding the asparagus, courgettes, and peppers and mix thoroughly
- Add the basil leaves and a splash of olive oil and mix together.
 Pile a little of the vegetable mixture on each pesto-smeared tartlet
- Break the mozzarella and place small bits on the top of each tart
- Bake on Low Humidity or SteamBake™ at 200°C for 20 minutes. (If using SteamBake™ remember to add 100ml water and preheat for 5 minutes before baking)
