The Pros & Cons of A Handleless Kitchen

The handleless kitchen trend actually started way back in the 1970s with the use of plain fronted doors with either aluminium or wooden trims fitted to the top or bottom of the doors to act as a handle. The popularity of this style has made a massive comeback in recent years, with a few twists and changes.







Handleless kitchen finishes have evolved massively over the years; the trend of mixing gloss, matte and wood finishes to achieve a two-tone kitchen has really soared. The juxtaposition of mixing door textures and colours is extremely popular, and can make a sleek and simple kitchen such as a handless one, really stand out!

Featuring a flat slab type of door with no raised panels or joins, ease of cleaning is a huge benefit of a handleless kitchen. With modern life becoming busier and busier, we want to spend less time cleaning and more time enjoying life. A handleless kitchen simply needs a wipe over; there is no need to worry about getting into any grooves or edges as there would be on a shaker style kitchen.

Another simple benefit of a handleless kitchen is that, when moving around the kitchen, there are no protruding handles to get "hooked" onto clothing. The design also lends itself to creating a very clean and modern appearance which is great for anyone looking to streamline the look of their kitchen.





One downfall of a handleless kitchen is that there can be limited grip on this type of door. Integrated appliances like dishwashers, fridges, and freezers can be a bit more difficult to open due to the smaller amount of grip available.

We ask our clients to think about this when choosing a handleless design as it can affect the dexterity of using the kitchen.

There are two main types of handleless kitchen; what we call a "J Trim" door and a "true" handleless style. The J trim style has a grip routed into the door, whereas the true handleless style uses a trim behind the door to allow opening. General feedback tends to confirm that most people find opening the true handleless style a bit easier due to achieving a better grip by pulling the back of the door to open it.

These are just a few things to think about when deciding whether or not a handleless kitchen is right for you. For more advice and insight on this style, feel free to give us a call; we always want to make sure you're choosing the right style for you and your needs!
