

Cook it with AEG

Beef Short Ribs Slow Cooked in Beer

• Prep time: 20 minutes

Cooking time: 4 hours (approximately)

• Servings: 4 people





This AEG recipe is the perfect winter treat, offering a cosy fall-off-the-bone finish that is ideal for a relaxed weekend dinner. This is the kind of dish that invites everyone to gather around the table, making it a wonderful choice as we move closer to the festive season.

ingredients

- 4 thick-cut, meaty beef short ribs, based on one per portion
- 1 large head of garlic
- 1 tbsp tomato purée
- 1 tbsp horseradish
- 1 tbsp English mustard
- 1 teaspoon garlic puree
- 1 x 330ml dark beer / bitter
- 1 litre beef stock
- 150g pancetta lardons
- 300g button mushrooms
- Chopped flat-leaf parsley
- Olive oil, for frying
- Thumb-sized piece of fresh horseradish, if available
- Salt and pepper

directions

- Season the ribs and brown them in an oven dish, then add the pancetta and cook until golden.
- Stir in the tomato purée for a minute, then pour in the beer and scrape the base of the pan.
- Add the stock, mustard, horseradish, garlic and mushrooms, bring to the boil and cover.
- Cook in the oven at 180°C for about 4 hours, basting occasionally, until the meat is falling from the bone.
- Remove the ribs, skim excess fat from the cooking liquid and reduce the sauce if needed.
- Check the seasoning, then garnish with parsley and fresh horseradish.

Tip: Serve with creamy mashed potatoes or steamed rice.
